## **BCEV Budget meeting June 5, 2023 5:00 pm**

In Attendance: Don Backman, Sydney Elliott, Liane Welch and Lois Cummings-Duncan

In discussion about how to spend the remaining money as wisely as possible:

Banners would be helpful to get the word out and create a public presence. Maybe 2, one with BCEV and one with Firewise. Liane has the info on who to use, etc. Estimate cost \$300 - \$400 for two. Liane has the logo.

The storage container came early! The "matching" funds can still come out of next fiscal year.

There needs to be an agreement of labor, job description, and reimbursement as appropriate for the new intern. She will be around here for a while and then back in August. Sydney has been working with her. (TC4 is jealous!)

There are some MREs in the sheds. Discussed MRE, canned food, Ramen, or dehydrated that you just add hot water. We do have some water and some filters.

WE also need low-power lights. Solar lights need to be charged. We also need a shorter term source. Chargeable lights would be good. LED?.

A 1000 watt generator will not run a refrigerator. 1500 will do more but is also more costly.

Toilet paper! We need that too.

High-Vis vests will be very helpful. They can be printed or patches added to identify your purpose like medical, block captain, etc. (Lois did take one.)

Liane and Don will meet and do the shopping on the Internet June 12, at 10 am.

When the next year starts we can put the big ticket items on it. A big ticket item for next year is Solar Panels for the new container.

Don is looking for grants for next year for power or solar.

Speaking of toileting we do have adult diapers.

Sydney wants to remind people to label their animals and have food solutions for them. Will we need rope, or tie outs?

CERT is needed. Don is going through the training and in South County Trina has.

ICS (Incident Command Service) training also, we need more people trained. See Sydney.
