

## Bay City Ordinances

## ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE TRANSPORTATION OF LOGS, POLES AND PILING ON CITY STREETS; PROHIBITING SUCH TRANSPORTATION WITHOUT A PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The city of Bay City ordains as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful, from and after the passage of this ordinance and its approval by the mayor, for any person or persons, firm or corporation to move, haul or transport any logs, poles or piling on or over any public street within the corporate limits of Bay City, Oregon, whether such street is improved or unimproved, without having first obtained a permit from the common council of Bay City so to do.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation desiring to obtain any such permit shall make written application to the common council of Bay City for such permit; and, which said application must contain the full name and address of the applicant, the street or portion of street over which said applicant proposes to haul said logs, poles or piling, the make, license number, number of axles and weight of the truck or other equipment to be used in such hauling, and that the applicant agrees to assume all responsibility for damage resulting to any street, culvert or bridge, and to any person or property on said street caused by the use of such equipment in transporting such logs, poles or piling; that applicant agrees to carry public liability and property damage insurance upon the same, and shall save Bay City harmless from any damage in connection with the permitted use of said equipment; that applicant will comply with such rules, regulations, restrictions and conditions as said common council may impose as a condition upon which such permit is granted, for the protection of such street, and that such permit shall be carried in such vehicle at all times.

Section 3. Any application for such permit shall be accompanied by a fee of \$10 for each vehicle to be used in such hauling, which said sum shall be refunded to such applicant if the permit is denied.

Section 4. All permits shall be void after the end of the calendar year in which such permit is issued.

Section 5. The common council of Bay City is hereby authorized to make rules and regulations, imposing load limits, time when hauling can be done, and any and all restrictions or conditions for the protection of such street under which such permit is granted. Any violation of such conditions shall render such permit null and void.

Section 6. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be punishable as a Class C violation, for each offense, as determined by the Tillamook County Justice Court, plus court costs. *Modified 05/08/01 by Ordinance 591*

Section 7. There being no Ordinance to regulate log hauling at the present time, it is hereby adjudged that existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be and become effective upon its passage and adoption by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor of Bay City, Oregon.
