# **General burning Information**

This burning permit is a privilege and not a right, it can be revoked at anytime by fire department officials if it appears that burning is being done in an unsafe manner. CAUTION: nothing within this permit relieves a person starting a fire from responsibility for providing adequate protection to prevent injury or damage to the person or property of another. We ask that individuals closely follow the burning regulations and have consideration for other citizens.

The Regulated closure of Oregon Department of Forestry land will result in the restriction of burning within the city.

Unless conditions warrant an earlier closure, Open burning will be closed on July 15, and burn barrels will be closed on August 1. Burning will be re-opened on October 15 if conditions permit.

These dates may be extended due to weather conditions, but all burning will be closed from Aug. 1 thru Oct.15. Burning conducted in violation of restrictions, or during closures will result in the City charging the offender for Fire Suppression Costs.

### Before you burn:

Remove all flammable material, dry grass etc... from within three feet of your burn barrel or pile. Have a charged hose or 5 gallon bucket of water on hand before starting your barrel or pile.

#### What can I burn?

Any dry organic material such as grass, limbs, yard debris, untreated wood scraps, paper, cardboard etc...

#### What can't I burn?

Oil, roofing, wet garbage, plastic, carpet, or any material that may release toxic gases into the atmosphere. Any living plants, trees, or shrubs. Any pressurized container.

#### What conditions must I avoid?

Do not burn in windy conditions. Do not burn or allow burning to continue after sunset.

**Do not burn** when a burn ban is in effect or conditions warrant added caution. Current burning conditions are posted on the Fire Department and City Hall, and are available by calling city hall 503 377-2288 or the fire department 503 377-0233. If in doubt, call before you burn.

# Working with your neighbors:

Please check with neighbors before you burn, do they have something planned that smoke may interfere with? If so then please consider alternative times to burn. We recommend that you limit burning to less than two hours a day.

# What should I do if my fire gets out of control?

Do not delay, call 911 and report the fire. You have a permit and accidents happen. The sooner we get there, the sooner we can control the fire.
