In accordance with Bay City Fire Department and DEQ regulations, the above Permittee is hereby granted permission to conduct burning according to the following:		
REGULATIONS		
<ol> <li>Burning piles shall be placed as far away as possible and reasonable from combustibles, structures, property lines and fences.</li> <li>A minimum of 25 feet is required for open debris piles and 10 feet for burn barrels from combustibles.</li> <li>Burn barrels are required to have a screen while burning. Screens should be made of heavy mesh and not less than 14 gauge wire with holes not larger than 3/8 inch.</li> <li>Burning of uncut grass, brush, or any standing vegetation is PROHIBITED. All grass, brush or vegetation must be piled prior to burning.</li> <li>Burning shall be done on ground cleared of all growth. Class 1 piles shall be in piles no more than 6 feet wide, 6 feet long, and 3 feet high (108 cubic feet). Piles larger than this shall require inspection by a fire officer. Contact 503-377-0233.</li> <li>BURNING AFTER DARK and during strong or gusty winds or when a burn ban is in effect is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.</li> <li>All fires shall be CONSTANTLY ATTENDED by a competent person until completely extinguished.</li> <li>Burning of rubber tires, plastics, paint, tar, asphalt shingles, wet garbage, petroleum products or any other material that creates a public nuisance is STRICTLY PROHIBITED by the Bay City Fire Department and DEQ regulations.</li> <li>All slash burning within the city limits is regulated by the Fire Department. Inspection before burning by the Fire Chief or his designee is required. Contact 503-377-0233.</li> <li>Burning that does not meet the regulations specified above will require a Class 3 Provisional Hazard Permit with approval from the Fire Chief or his designee.</li> </ol>

# **General burning Information**

This burning permit is a privilege and not a right, it can be revoked at anytime by fire department officials if it appears that burning is being done in an unsafe manner. CAUTION: nothing within this permit relieves a person starting a fire from responsibility for providing adequate protection to prevent injury or damage to the person or property of another. We ask that individuals closely follow the burning regulations and have consideration for other citizens.

The Regulated closure of Oregon Department of Forestry land will result in closure to burning within the City.

Unless conditions warrant an earlier closure, all debris burning will be closed on July 15. Burning will be reopened on October 15 if conditions permit. These dates may be extended due to weather conditions, but all burning will be closed from July 15 thru Oct. 15.

Burning conducted in violation of restrictions, or during closures will result in the City charging the offender for Fire Suppression costs.

### Before you burn:

Remove all flammable material, dry grass etc... from within three feet of your burn barrel or pile. Have a charged hose or 5 gallon bucket of water on hand before starting your barrel or pile.

#### What can I burn?

Any *dry* organic material such as grass, limbs, yard debris, untreated wood scraps, paper, cardboard, etc...

#### What can't I burn?

Oil, roofing, wet garbage, freshly cut debris, plastic, carpet, or any material that may release toxic gases into the atmosphere. Any living plants, trees, or shrubs. Any pressurized container.

#### What conditions must I avoid?

Do not burn in windy conditions. Do not burn or allow burning to continue after sunset. **Do not burn** when a burn ban is in effect or conditions warrant added caution. Current burning conditions are posted on the Fire Department and City Hall, and are available by calling city hall 503-377-2288 or the fire department 503-377-0233. If in doubt, call before you burn.

# Working with your neighbors:

Please check with neighbors before you burn, do they have something planned that smoke may interfere with? If so then please consider alternative times to burn. We recommend that you limit burning to less than two hours a day.

#### What should I do if my fire gets out of control?

Do not delay, call 911 and report the fire. You have a permit and accidents happen. The sooner we get there, the sooner we can control the fire.
