Public Protection Classification As of August 1, 2014, our public protection classification is ISO Class 3.

Training Our Fire Department meets every Wednesday evening for training drills. We receive hands-on fire and medical training while also attending to apparatus and building maintenance. In addition, we also have many weekend and other evening trainings, always striving to maintain the highest level of readiness.

Burn permits To burn outdoors or in a burn barrel, a new burn permit must be obtained each calendar year. Burn permits may be obtained by contacting City Hall at 503.377.2288 or the Fire Department at 503.377.0233.

Is burning allowed? Watch for upcoming seasonal burning restrictions. You may easily determine if it is a burning day by checking the sign posted on the front of the Fire Department building. If the sign is green, burning is allowed with permit. If the sign is red, no burning is allowed. If the sign is yellow, burning is allowed in burn barrels only with permit. Most open burn piles require inspection by the Fire Department prior to lighting off. Please burn responsibly and only with a valid permit.
